

**CHESS REGULATIONS** Last Update 01.04.2022

## 1. Organization

- The Chess Committee of the 21st Maccabiah will be responsible for the Chess competitions of the 21st Maccabiah. a.
- All the Chess events will be played according to the FIDE rules and regulations, its interpretations and supplements will be binding. b.
- The Chess Committee of the 21st Maccabiah will determine the venues and times of the Chess competitions and players will be c. notified accordingly and register the Chess competitions.
- d. The Chess committee is authorized to make changes as deemed necessary.
- The results of the games will count towards the FIDE ratings. e.

# 2. <u>Closed Tournament – International Grand Masters</u>

- Participation in this event is open to International Grand Masters, to International Masters, and players who have at least 2500 ELO a. but are not International Masters yet.
- b. Ten players will be able to participate in this event, league style.
- Match will be played by the Fischer method (match length 2 hours + 30 seconds for each move). c.
- d. Determination of first place will be as follows:
  - Number of points scored by the player. 1)
  - 2) According to the Berger System (sum of all the points of those opponents whom they won against, plus the sum of half the points of those opponents they drew against).
  - 3) The result between the players that scored the most points.
  - 4) Blitz games, Double Round, between the players with the highest score.

### 3. Closed Tournament

- Participation in this event is open to International Grand Masters, to International Masters, and players who have at least 2500 ELO a. but are not International Masters yet.
- Ten players will be able to participate in this event, league style. b.
- Match will be played by the Fischer method (match length 2 hours + 30 seconds for each move). с.
- d. Determination of first place will be as follows:
  - Number of points scored by the player. 1)
  - 2) According to the Berger System (sum of all the points of those opponents whom they won against, plus the sum of half the points of those opponents they drew against).
  - 3) The result between the players that scored the most points.
  - 4) Blitz games, Double Round, between the players with the highest score.

### 4. Open Tournament

- Participation in this event is open to all Fide rated players, and each country may send three unrated players. a.
- b. The event will be held according to the Swiss System in nine rounds and a computer will do the pairing.
- Match will be played by the Fischer method (match length 2 hours + 30 seconds for each move). c.
- d. Determination of first place will be as follows:
  - 1) Number of points scored by the player.
  - 2) According to the Bucholtz System.
  - 3) According to the Median System.
  - 4) Blitz games, Double Round, between the players with the highest score.

### 5. Junior Tournament

- Participation in this event is open to all FIDE rated players, and each country may send five unrated players. a.
- Participation in the competition is open to any athlete who is in possession of a Participant Card, issued by the Organizing Committee b. of the 21st Maccabiah and registered for the Chess competition.
- The event will be held according to the Swiss System in nine rounds and a computer will do the pairing. c.
- d. The rate of play is 2 hours for the finish match.
- Determination of first place will be as follows:
- - Number of points scored by the player. 1)
  - 2) According to the Bucholtz System.
  - 3) According to the Median System.
  - 4) Blitz games, Double Round, between the players with the highest score.

#### 6. General

These regulations are but one part of the complete 21st Maccabiah Regulations and must be read along with the instructions found a. in the Maccabiah Basic Regulations.
